## Insights For Selling To Jennifer

### 👉 During A Call Or A Meeting

#### DO's

- During followups, use phone or text if needed, they should be fine
- Let them know of potential risks but suggest mitigation methods alongside
- Stick to your standard pitch and qualifying script, don't try to wing it

#### DONT's

- Don't go over them unless you are left with no other option
- Don't shy away from asking hard questions, but be extra polite
- Don't focus too much on mutual contacts or bother about other stakeholders, focus on them

## 👉 When Cold Calling

### Insights

**Pattern Interrupt:** Confident style, with a mix of informality and formality gets their attention.

**Pace:** Speak slightly fast. Sound like a 'gets shit done' person.

**Tone:** Do not sound too eager, as if you have met a friend suddenly after a long time. Keep the tone calm but confident.

**Tactics To Win:** Strong words, focus on results, respectful confidence

**Mistakes To Avoid:** Apologizing, nervousness, information overload, social proof

**Making The Ask:** Confidently, ask for 10-15 minutes. Allude to the results and outcomes that are possible. They care about the ends more than the means.

**Subconscious Driver:** Results and outcomes are what matter to them. Any credible shot at getting results will appeal to them quickly.

### Script

**Greeting:** Jennifer, this is [user\_fname] at [user\_companynamewordstwowords].

**Opener:** In 30 seconds if I could share how 100% of your sellers could kick ass this year, can I go for it?

**Introduction:** We have built an AI that predicts exactly what would matter to your buyer before you even meet them.

**Ask:** Can I put 15 minutes on your calendar to show you how this changes outcomes for you?

**Close:** [time1] on [date1] sounds good? Or would you prefer [time2] on [date2]? And [prospect\_email] works well?

## 👉 When Writing An Email

**Subject:** To the point, formal

*Example: Personalized sales funnel', 'Sales conversion' etc.*

**Salutation:** No

*Example: Skip 'Hi', 'Hey' etc., use only the first name*

**Greeting:** No

*Example: Skip lines like 'I hope you are doing well'*

**Emojis/GIFs:**

**Bullet Points:** Could use

**Closing Line:** Formally state your ask

*Example: Something like 'If you are available tomorrow, shall we discuss this?'*

**Complimentary Close:** None or standard

*Example: Something simple like 'Thanks', 'Regards', or nothing at all.*

**Tone of Words:** Confident with a formal touch

**Overall Messaging:** Focused on output

**Length of Mail:** Short

*Example: Maximum upto 100-120 words*

## 👉 While Negotiating & Closing

The secret to closing fast with Jennifer is

- *Strong proof of impact and their conviction will matter the most, but they wouldn't want to act unilaterally either*

Will you ever get a clear answer from Jennifer

- *They will say no if they are not convinced but you will have to prompt them.*

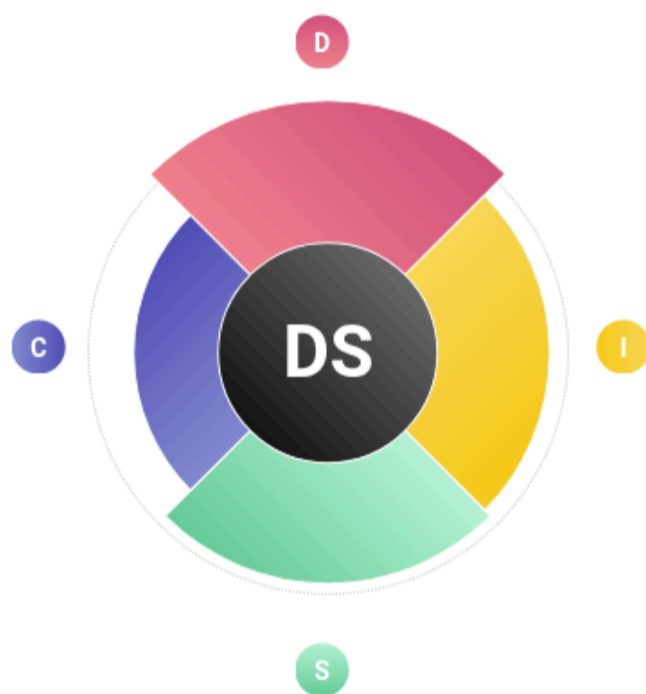
- *They have good risk tolerance but are likely to think it through once or twice.*
