Insights For Selling To Phillip

👉 During A Call Or A Meeting

DO's

- Ask them questions confidently while doing discovery, don't be apologetic
- Get to the point quickly instead of spending too much time on pleasantries
- Tell them that you are there to help them create visible impact within their organization

DONT's

- Avoid long winding pitches, stay objective
- Do not give up if they are not convinced, try again with a different approach
- Avoid repeating yourself or making generalizations

👉 When Cold Calling

Insights

Pattern Interrupt: Confident style, with a mix of informality and formality gets their attention.

Pace: Speak slightly fast. Sound like a 'gets shit done' person.

Tone: Do not sound too eager, as if you have met a friend suddenly after a long time. Keep the tone calm but confident.

Tactics To Win: Strong words, focus on results, respectful confidence

Mistakes To Avoid: Apologizing, nervousness, information overload, social proof

Making The Ask: Confidently, ask for 10-15 minutes. Allude to the results and outcomes that are possible. They care about the ends more than the means.

Subconscious Driver: Results and outcomes are what matter to them. Any credible shot at getting results will appeal to them quickly.

Script

Greeting: Phillip, this is [user_fname] at [user_companynamewordstwowords].

Opener: In 30 seconds if I could share how 100% of your sellers could kick ass this year, can I go for it?

Introduction: We have built an AI that predicts exactly what would matter to your buyer before you even meet them.

Ask: Can I put 15 minutes on your calendar to show you how this changes outcomes for you?

Close: [time1] on [date1] sounds good? Or would you prefer [time2] on [date2]? And [prospect_email] works well?

👉 When Writing An Email

Subject: To the point

Example: Personalization', 'Sales conversion' etc.

Salutation: No

Example: Skip 'Hi', 'Hey' etc., use only the first name

Greeting: No

Example: Skip lines like 'I hope you are doing well'

Emojis/GIFs:

Bullet Points: Could use

Closing Line: Clearly state your ask

Example: Something like 'Can we get on a call tomorrow at 1100 hours and finalize this?'

Complimentary Close: None or standard

Example: Skip 'Warm regards', 'Best wishes' etc., just write your name

Tone of Words: Confident, challenging

Overall Messaging: Focused on results

Length of Mail: Very Short

Example: Less than 75 words

👉 While Negotiating & Closing

The secret to closing fast with Phillip is

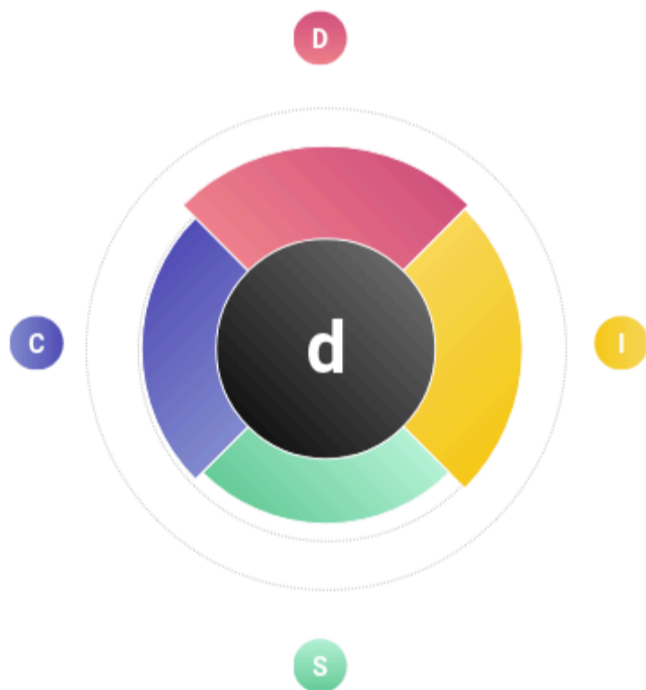
